About Our School

Our History

2001

Pierre van Ryneveld Christian Academy was established in January 2001 in the nursery school building previously known as Pierryntjie Nursery School using the ACE curriculum. In the beginning, PvRCA opened its doors with a total of 16 learners: eight GRADE 1's and eight other learners in the rest of the school with a total of 2 teachers excluding management.

2003

During 2003 we built the double story classroom, but only completed the top story, leaving the bottom part open for more playground area.

2007

Finally in 2007 the ground floor was completed after we got permission to use the playground area next to the school.

2012

A sport's ground for our students was developed at the end of 2012.

PRESENT

The school building now consists of 15 classrooms including the Computer Class, Gr R and Gr RR, and Media Centre.

In 2015 we added the **CAPS** curriculum making it possible to write the National Senior Certificate. This is a significant development in the school's future as by this we now make it possible for the whole community to get schooling in **English**.

Our Curriculum

Pierre van Ryneveld Private school utilizes the Curriculum Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS) as required by the Department of Basic Education.

Grade 8 to 9 (9 compulsory subjects):

Home Language, First Additional Language, Mathematics, Natural Sciences, Life Orientation, Social Sciences, Creative Arts, Economic and Management Sciences, and Technology.

Grade 10 to 12 subjects:

Home Language, First Additional Language, Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy, and Life Orientation. Choice subjects include Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Computer Applications Technology, Information Technology, Geography, Dramatic Arts, Visual Arts, Religion Studies, Accounting, Business Studies, Economics, Engineering Graphics and Design, Hospitality Studies, and Tourism.
