Through our thorough and structured school readiness programme, children are stimulated intellectually, emotionally, socially and physically during all stages of child development.

Our Facilities:

With the little ones in mind we created an environment which is colourful, spacious and has a variety of equipment. This gives them the opportunity to develop their gross and fine motor skills and also to learn while they have fun. We keep our groups small, because we want to give each unique child the necessary attention in order to help them to reach their full potential.

Our staff:

They are well qualified and trained and they have been through the Police Clearance Process. The principal has 38 years of experience and is SACE registered.

Rules and Regulations 2020

Arrival and departure times

Children are received between 06:30 to 07:00 in a waiting class. The babies must go directly to the baby room. As of 07:00, children are to be dropped off in their own classes. Please

note that children must not be left at the gate but should be handed over to the person on duty.

Please see that your child is at school in his / her class before 08:00. Our school's program starts at 08:00 with breakfast. If your child arrive after 08:00, we will appreciate it if he/she enjoys breakfast at home to ensure that we do not start late with our program.

Departure time: Children must be collected personally by parents and signed out (we don't want them to walk to the cars alone). Parents are urgently requested not to be late, as it is upsetting for them if all the other children leave and they are kept waiting.

Safety and security

Please provide a copy of an ID document of the person who will be collecting your child in advance and phone the school to make arrangements if someone else will collect your child. We have a monitored remote gate control handled by a responsible staff member. Parents have to sign children out in the afternoon.

We have taken all necessary steps and every precautionary measure that is available for the safety of our children but unfortunately no responsibility will be accepted for any injuries or accidents that may occur. Please be assured that permanent supervision will be maintained at all times.

We also have a Health/Food and Fire certificate.

Refreshments and food

Breakfast is served at 08:00, light refreshment at 10:00, lunch at 12:00, and light refreshment at 15:00 – all provided by the school. We prefer it that you send a fruit every day for snack time at 10:00. You are welcome to pack a late snack for 16:30 for your child if your supper is being served late.

Children are not allowed to bring sweets or toys for themselves or their friend as this may cause a lot of unnecessary tears for the other friends.

The Nursery School - Reception Year (Grade R)

Our grade R is registered at the Department of Education and by following the CAPS curriculum our aim is that at the end of Grade R, there will be a school readiness test done to assess if they will be fully equipped to thrive in school and if they are well-balanced, confident young children. - With specific emphasis on our weekly theme, their vocabulary is expanded in order to gain more knowledge and experience of the world around them. This is enhanced by regular trips and excursions as well as educational visits.

Development of Critical and Creative Thinking Skills

- Science - basic science experiments are carried out according to the weekly theme with task completion supported by the teacher

Soccer

Soccercise Starz is a well-balanced football program aimed at children between the ages of 2-6. B sharp Beatle-Music Appreciation this is included in the school fees

Music is one of the most potent performing arts and can have a great effect on a child's total development. Children participating in music, achieve some or other form of success, considering that it is experienced individually. This success leads to a sense of confidence and self-worth and gives the child courage to attempt more difficult learning tasks.

The following are important to keep your children happy

3 months to 2 years

Please make sure that the following are in your baby's bag to ensure him / her having a great day in which we can meet all their needs:

- 6 or more nappies as we change them at 08h30 / 10h30 / 12h30 / 14h30 / 16h30 + one for a soiled nappy in between.
- Clean bottles with the correct amount of boiled water in it.
- Container with correct amount of measured milk powder / formula in it.
- Wipes and bum cream
- One set of extra clothing which will only be used when necessary – should the child mess or have a runny tummy and the clothes are dirty, messy or wet.
- We do have a menu at school. Should your child not be able to eat the schools food, which I would like to encourage from 12 month onwards, please ensure that there is breakfast for 08h00, snack for 10h00, lunch for 12h00(included in the school fees) and another snack for 15h00 all provided by the parents.
- 3 face clothes
- 1 box of tissues

2 to 6 years

- One set of extra clothing which will only be used when necessary – should the child mess or have a runny tummy and the clothes are dirty, messy or wet.
- We do have a menu at school. Should your child not be able to eat the schools food, which I would like to encourage from 12 month onwards, please ensure that there is breakfast for 08h00, snack for 10h00, lunch for 12h00(included in the school fees) and another snack for 15h00 all provided by the parents.
- A list of stationary will be given to each child which will be used during the year.

Notice of absence

Parents are kindly requested to inform the school before 9am in the morning.

Children with contagious diseases must be kept at home until the disease has cleared up. No learner on antibiotics may attend school or if they have any of the following symptoms 12 hours before a new school day: Vomiting, diarrhoea, temperature higher than 38, skin rash of unknown cause as well as lice. Children with lice are to be kept home until the condition has cleared 100% to prevent infestation.

Should your child have a fever, vomit or have diarrhoea at school you will be requested to collect the child ASAP. **No Medicine will be administered unless with parents' permission.**

Clothing

Parents are requested to see to it that children wear comfortable clothes in which they can play and get dirty, because their "work" includes playing with paint, water, sand and mud.

Please make sure that your little girl **wears a pair of shorts under her dress**, should she wish to wear a dress to school. Also remember to sun block your child. Please send a hat to school.

During toilet training accidents are likely to occur and sets of clean clothes should always be available.

Clothing must please be marked clearly and placed in a bag bearing the child's name on the outside.

Please note we cannot be held responsible for any loss of clothing, shoes or any other item that may go missing. Children are encourage to place their belongings in their bags when they remove it, and we will always assist as much as possible.

Fees

- Fees are payable monthly in advance **over a 12 month period**, thus including December.
- Fees should be received **on or before the third day of each month**.
- A registration fee is payable each year and is non refundable
- School fees will be revised every year
- We will also not be liable for any money that goes missing from a Childs bag.
- Should money or proof of payment not be received by the 7th of the month a penalty will be applicable and added to your late payment.

On the 3rd day of each month the bank statement will be inspected for incoming fees. Should the fees not reflect, a notification will be sent out by sms.

Should the school fee + penalty fee not be received by the end of the working day (the 3rd) the Childs tuition **will be suspended until payment and penalty fees have been received.**

- A written notice of one calendar month is required prior to removing your child from the school. Failure to do so will render you liable for payment of a month's fees.
- The full monthly fee for December will be payable even though the school officially closes from approximately the second week of December until the first week in January.
- Children leaving the school the end of the year are still obligated to pay for December.
- 0.5% discount per month will be applicable to all parents/guardians who pay their annual school fees in advance.
